

## **OMRRA 2010 Contingency, CONFIRMED**

### **ACME MOTOWEAR:**

ACME is going to provide an end of season (2010) payout for the participants of WMRRA and OMRRA wearing ACME purchased PSI and Gimoto suits.

1. Purchase or have purchased a suit from us (ACME) by December 1st, 2009.
2. Sport some really cool ACME stickers on your race bike, one on each side. (ACME provided)
3. Payout will be as follows at the end of the 2010 race season for OMRRA and WMRRA racing organizations:
  - a.) \$200 for best overall finisher wearing an ACME purchased suit in the top 10.
  - b.) \$100 for best overall finisher wearing an ACME purchased suit in positions 11 through 20.
  - c.) \$50 for best overall finisher wearing an ACME purchased suit in positions 21 through 30.
4. If no rider with an ACME purchased suit is in the top 10, but more than one is in the 11 through 20, the top 2 in that position will receive \$100 each. If no one is in the top 20, then 3 payouts of \$50 each will be awarded to the top 3 in positions 21 through 30. If results are different than stated above, then ACME will decide how the money is distributed amongst the ACME riders.
5. If you are awarded contingency in 2010 you are no longer eligible for contingency in future years unless you purchase another suit. We want to spread the money around to as many different riders as we can and not just be giving away to the same handful of racers every year.
6. You are automatically enrolled in the program if you have already purchased a suit from us and also if you purchase one prior to December 1st, 2009. After that date, you will be eligible for the 2011 race season contingency program. No wiggle room on the deadline.
7. Winnings will be awarded at the respective Banquets.

Payable to the rider who finishes the highest and makes up the most positions in the race (i.e., starts 20<sup>th</sup> and finishes 4<sup>th</sup> is better than starting 15<sup>th</sup> and finishing 3<sup>rd</sup>.)

Contingency coordinator will need to provide the information to operations to generate the certificates once the race results are finalized

Certificates valid for 90 days from the issue date

Racer must be a MotoClub member to receive contingency

## **PIT BULL:**

## **VALLDOG DESIGN:**

Welcome to the 2010 Contingency Program offered by Valldog Design. Thank you to all participants and I look forward to some great competition and some great looking rides. ### **RULES**

1. There will be three awards offered to three riders following the 2010 season. The sum of all total OMRRA points will determine the winners of the program.
2. Riders eligible for this program will be 2010, Valldog design race season customers. If one rider has multiple bikes or projects, one project only, has to be finished in order to qualify. A finished project counts as one total paint job.
3. Any 2009 riders, currently customers, that want to participate that do not need 2010 work must sign

agreement that for the next work to be done will be done exclusively through Valldog Design.

4. All participants must display a 10 inch [www.valldogdesign.com](http://www.valldogdesign.com) sticker or a six by six inch logo sticker on each side and clearly visible.

5. All participants must include Valldog Design on their sponsor list to be announced and viewed as a rider sponsor.

6. Participants will have their images on [www.valldogdesign.com](http://www.valldogdesign.com) as a sponsored rider and the bike fully viewed.

7. Eligible times to enroll into the program start from Oct 13th to the end of 2010 season.

8. Points will be pulled from overall OMRRA standings awarded to Valldog design participants

9. All riders must be registered as participant through Valldog design.

10. All awards will be given after scoring is finalize
