PIT NUMBERS!

One of the new rules for next year states that Pits should be identified with the number of the Racers. These numbers make both Blinky and ASIT's jobs much easier when they are trying to find where to go. One easy way to do this is to get a plastic number plate, put your number on it, and zip tie it to your tent. Another easy way to do this is to write directly on the tent itself if you know your number isn't ever going to change!



2016 RULES PROPOSAL RESULTS

All the final rules proposal were passed by the membership. See the Forum for a detailed breakdown of voting results and download the 2016 Rule Book. Hard copies of the Rule Book will also be available at the Tower during the Season. Make sure to familiarize yourself with any renamed classes and any new specifications for the classes that may affect you and your bike(s).

2016 RACE PRICING

The cost of racing will remain the same as 2015, with a minor exception. OMRRA will no longer offer Value Classes - instead all races will follow the same simple price structure (omrra/pricing). Ways to save on entry fees include Pre-Entering by Wednesday night before the event which saves \$30 over post-entering at track, and buying a Season Gate Pass for only \$95 which saves \$25 over the race season and gets you into PIR at no extra charge on Friday Evenings.
