#### 3) Financial report - Taneka

-Still able to maintain Money Market account balance above \$10,000

-We cannot compare financials with any prior years due to current circumstances and because we have not held a race round, so year over year comparison is irrelevant.

-July 1st is the deadline to bind OMRRA's insurance policy (\$7,000 expenditure). There is a high risk of losing the premium if we bind the policy, and then are unable to run both (or any) rounds in 2020. -COVID-19 requirements will increase the costs associated with running a race round, due to extra costs associated with PPE requirements.

-PIR Track Rental deposits are refundable or transferable to a future event. OMRRA currently has an \$11,000 deposit on file.

#### 4) New Business

a) IRF Donations:

-Currently IRF has more than adequate funds (\$19,000 held, which is a 3+ year stockpile) -Instead of requesting donations to IRF, OMRRA should seek donations to the general fund to assist in sustaining the club until racing can resume.

-These donations would be separately identified as "support" donations to assist in isolating their impact. -Mark explained that OMRRA's financial situation should be made clear to all members, in that the club has been sustained the past several years by its fundraisers, and that the grim reality is that the basic operating financial model is not sustainable with the lack of registration numbers since 2017.

b) IRF Nominations

-Josh made a motion to distribute a \$200 IRF payment to OMRRA Member Kris Le to assist in recovery from injuries sustained in his garage. **Vote: All in Favor, Unanimous.** 

c) Admin/Legal

-Some Trackday providers have been able to use electronically signed waivers, that were completed prior to their event. OMRRA will look into the feasibility of doing this, and specifically for the COVID-19 waivers that will be required. There have been issues in the past that have prevented the deployment of electronic waivers.

-There are questions as to whether OMRRA's current insurance policy will cover COVID-19 related claims.

d) Round 1 Deliberations

-Alex discussed the option for declaring both remaining OMRRA PIR rounds "double points" rounds. This must be decided before the season starts, according to the rulebook. It would restore the balance between home and away points towards OMRRA's championships.

-A go/no-go registration revenue threshold must be determined, to decide if a July round will be feasible. The best estimate of entry fee gross revenue required to succeed in July is \$40,000.

-NRS will not use a Track Day session on Friday of the July round, so there is no need to pay OPRT for this.

e) Round 1 Readiness

-Volunteer Availability:

-Betty said previously that she would run the Crash Truck. Rick from WMRRA is available, although that will cost OMRRA for his travel and lodging.

-OMRRA will reach out to volunteers to gauge the intent to participate in a July round, and provide a summary of the general COVID-19 guidelines that are expected.

-Justin to reach out to Referees to make sure of their availability.

f) Novice Program

-There are 10 newly licensed Novice Racers who have been able to attend an NRS class with other recognized organizations.. The plans for additional new novices in July are in flux still. A virtual classroom session will be had with these new participants prior to the July round.

g) Sponsorship

-OMRRA still does not have solid information to give potential sponsors as to whether or not we can run race rounds.

-Keith offered that OMRRA should communicate with sponsors the need for financial support during this time, and offer reduced cost (\$250 class sponsorships) for some exposure and support of the club. -Mark, Alex and Travis will continue this sponsorship conversation.

## h) Elections

-Nominations for 2021 BOD open in July. We need to verify that the elections committee is fully staffed.
