i) GMM Recap

- 1) Budget was approved
- 2) Consider changing venue (Slingshot Lounge is 21+)
- 3) Acoustics could be better, both in person and for virtual experience
- 4) New Race Director: Mark Wilson
- 5) PIR not very responsive lately, improved since GMM due to phone conversations. Local city politics have changed such that PIR no longer operates independently and does not have direct control/access to their financial accounts.
- 6) Discussion about basic bikes classes (read: cheap/easy to prepare for) to lower the barrier to entry.
- 7) Consider LeMans start as an attraction for vintage racers, or other classes.

- 5) PIR had a volunteer fair the same day, just before OMRRA event. Keep in mind for the future to avoid schedule conflicts and potential delegate to PIR event.

iii) Video Project Update for Feedback

- 1) Preston, videographer for Nectar, is available for creating OMRRA videos. Initial meeting was promising and produced the following budgetary quotes. Costs are highly competitive for market rate, and his work is professional level.

- 2) Everything recorded/produced would be the property of OMRRA.
- 3) Quoted Costs:
 - (a) 1 × (0:30–1:00) Social cutdown from existing footage — \$450
 - (b) 1 × Filming day for opening weekend at Portland International Raceway — \$800
 - (i) Consider later in the year, such as Supercorn weekend
 - (c) 1 × (1:30–3:00) Website hero edit featuring racers, volunteers, and fans — \$1200
 - (d) 3 × (0:30–1:00) Social cutdowns from the hero video — \$200 each
- iv) Events: Breah
 - 1) Motocorsa Track Day w/ Dave Moss - May 17th
 - 2) Cycle Gear Bike Nights - April 14th & May 12th
 - 3) Consider an OMRRA presence at Andy DiBrino's track days at Pats Acres.
- v) Round 1 Readiness
 - 1) Licensing status
 - (a) 80 Confirmed, 12 on hold. A little low compared to previous years.
 - (b) License confirmation email to go out in April, with instructions for digital license access.
 - 2) Track day registration events on MSR
 - (a) No major changes from last year. Jason to clone events from last year and update for 2026.
 - 3) Track day registrar
 - (a) Diane plans to do track day registrar duties for 2026.
- vi) Honoring Eugene Brown at PIR
 - 1) Laps of Honor
 - (a) OMRRA policy to no longer do laps of honor for racers who pass away. OMRRA's founder, Eugene Brown, is a valid exception to that policy.
 - (b) One-time exception to policy: Laps of Honor following the conclusion of races on Saturday of the first race weekend.
 - 2) Eugene's bikes on display
 - 3) Race in Eugene's name
 - (a) Consider LeMans start for as many vintage bikes make sense in one track session. Likely Round 2. Could be disconnected from Eugene Brown celebration.
 - (b) Consider name change from "Formula 40" to "Formula Forever", possibly for 2026 only or permanent change.
 - (c) Address these ideas in April meeting, or offline.
- vii) Safety Improvements for 2026
 - 1) Continually need to be working on safety improvement project ideas. PIR is not accepting proposals for infrastructure changes in 2026.
